

#### CARES Act

- CARES Act in approved State Budget//League Success
- Provides \$12/capita for Cities
- SJ = 51,028 (pop) x \$12 = \$612,336 in eligible funding
- Must apply via DOF DCM Prill has accomplished this
- Cannot be used to backfill lost revenue



#### CARES Act

- Must be used for COVID related expenses
- City has many related expenses including but not limited to:
  - -Equipment for staff to work from home
  - -Web equipment/programs like virtual private network
  - -Gaiters/masks and personal protection equipment for staff in the field and/or office environment
  - -Web development time to create COVID webpage and keep it updated



#### CARES Act

- -Public Oriented Policing and Fire/Parademic calls on related COVID issues
- -Only expense items can be applied for cannot be used to backfill loss of revenue or add new services ...

We cannot count on this State assistance but the City will apply for its share of funds and remain hopeful of getting some



#### Street Sweeping Program to Resume 8/3/2020

- In mid-March the City Council suspended street sweeping enforcement as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Enforcement of posted parking restrictions for Street Sweeping Program will resume August 3, 2020.
- On August 3, 2020 citations will be issued to vehicles parked on streets during posted street sweeping times.
- Residents should review the street sweeping signs posted at the entrance of neighborhoods to determine the street sweeping day to avoid fines.
- Street sweeping improves the City by removing trash from the neighborhoods and prevents harmful pollutants from affecting downstream watersheds.


