**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2023-24 FUNDED BY SB 1:THE ROAD
REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City of San Jacinto are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Jacinto must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Jacinto, will receive an estimated \$1,349,552 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2023-24 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the seventh year in which the City of San Jacinto is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City of San Jacinto to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Jacinto has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Jacinto used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority

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and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City of San Jacinto maintain and rehabilitate high priority corridors and local roads throughout the City of San Jacinto this year and additional similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City of San Jacinto's streets and roads are at "high-risk" condition (Pavement Condition Index 50-60) and the SB1 RMRA revenues will help the City of San Jacinto increase the overall quality of its road system to a "good" condition (Pavement Condition Index 71-100) over the next decade; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials, and practices, will have significant positive impacts locally, regionally, and statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED, AND FOUND by the San Jacinto City Council, State of California, as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2. The following list of newly proposed projects will be funded in part or solely with Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

- Project Title: State Street Pavement Rehabilitation (Seventh Street to Idyllwild Drive) (CIP # 24-001)
- Project Description: Pavement Rehabilitation
- Project Location: 7100-foot segment of State Street between Seventh Street and Idyllwild Drive
- Estimated Project Schedule: Construction anticipated June 2024 and completed August 2024
- Estimated Project Useful Life: 12 years

SECTION 3. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may also utilize Fiscal Year 2023-24 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City of San Jacinto is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

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- Project Title: Ramona Expressway Rehabilitation (CIP # 21-001)
- Project Description: Pavement Rehabilitation
- Project Location: East Bound Ramona Expressway, 200' East of Warren Road to west city limits
- Estimated Project Schedule: Started construction Oct 2022, anticipated completion August 2023
- Estimate Project Useful Life: 10 years

- Project Title: Mountain Avenue Rehabilitation (CIP #12-008)
- Project Description: Pavement Rehabilitation
- Project Location: Mountain Avenue from Seventh St. to Esplanade Ave.
- Estimate Project Schedule: Started October 2022 – Completion estimated August 2023
- Estimated Project Useful Life: 10 years

- Project Title: San Jacinto Street Pavement and Sidewalk Improvement Project (CIP # 21-006 formerly known as Artesia Avenue Pavement Rehabilitation & Sidewalk Improvements)
- Project Description: Pavement Rehabilitation and Sidewalk Improvements
- Project Location: Artesia Avenue from Camino Los Baños to N. Jordan Ave.
- Estimated Project Schedule: Construction started May 2022; completion by August 2023.
- Estimated Project Useful Life: 10 years

- Project Title: Pavement Management System (CIP # CP-004)
- Project Description: Creation of the City's Pavement Management System
- Project Location: Citywide
- Estimated Project Schedule: December 2023
- Estimated Project Useful Life: On-going updates after pavement management completion
