The proposed Project would develop an approximately 33.8-acre vacant site with up to 181 single-family residential homes and associated infrastructure. The Project requires subdividing five (5) existing parcels (APNs 436-280-011, 436-280-012, 436-280-013, 436-280-014 and 436-280-025). The total Project footprint is approximately 35.06 acres, which includes both the approximately 33.8-acre Project site and 1.26-acre offsite improvement area. Offsite improvements include connecting the proposed internal circulation system to the intersections of Lyon Avenue/Appaloosa Drive and Marilyn Drive/Estrella Street; connecting to existing utility systems within Lyon Avenue; frontage improvements along Lyon Avenue
