PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

FOR THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Riverside County Ordinance No. 533 empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence of a Local Emergency when the County Board of Supervisors is not in session, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services finds:

- (1)That at the time of this proclamation the County Board of Supervisors is not is session:
- (2)That over recent days conditions of disaster or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have occurred throughout the State of California, including within the cities of Los Angeles, Long Beach, and Santa Monica, as a result of civil unrest, violence, looting, arson, and the destruction of personal and real property;
- (3)That such conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property may arise within the County of Riverside; and
- (4)That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril may arise warrant and necessitate the proclamation of a Local Emergency; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a Local Emergency exists throughout the County of Riverside, commencing on or about June 1, 2020, and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said Local Emergency, the powers, functions and duties of the Director of Emergency Services shall be those prescribed by state law and the ordinances, resolutions, and approved plan of the County of Riverside in order to mitigate the effects of said Local Emergency, and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that said Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist for the next seven (7) days, and hereafter by ratification of the County Board of Supervisors, until its termination is proclaimed by the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside.
